WHATS ON THE SEASHORE?

Can you find any of the creatures below while safely exploring your local seashore?

These sea creatures love to hide in rockpools when the tide is out!



Beadlet AnenomeFound in Rockpools; Most are red, but some are brown, green or orange; their tentacles trap passing prey



Common Starfish
Found in rockpools year
round; like to eat mussels
and clams; move using
suckers on their base.



Brown Shrimp
Loves to live in muddy and sandy shores; It camouflages itself in the sand for protection; Can be seen yearround



Common GobyCan grow up to 7cm long:

Periwinkle



Green Shore Crab

Can grow up to 7cm long; live in shallow water and rockpools at low tide; Live for just 1 year Also known as a Sea Snail; Eats seaweeds & algae; Lives on rocky shores and rockpools; They are a favourite food of seabirds!

Found in rocpools; Eats seaweed, mussels and barnacles; Has 5 spikes on each side of its top shell (called a **carapace**!)



Mussel

Bivalves; Can be found year round; Filter feeder that eats microscopic pieces of food using tiny tentacles!



Limpet

Lives on rocks and can be found year-round; Feeds on seaweed using a tongue to graze!; Their shell is conical.



Barnacles

Found on living on the rocks, piers, old boats and other animals!; They open up when the tide comes in & eat plankton.
