

The Geography of Glendalough:

About Your Fieldtrip

We shall be exploring the geography of the valley of Glendalough.

Glendalough means 'Valley of Two Lakes'.

This is a mountain area, and it is important that you are properly prepared and equipped.



Today you will be spending a lot of time outside. Please ensure to bring warm, water-proof clothing. Weather conditions can be changeable in the mountains and temperatures drop as you gain altitude. It is advisable to bring numerous <u>layers</u> of clothing and hats & gloves are recommended year-round. Bring a nutritious packed lunch and some fluids. You may also find it useful to bring a camera and perhaps even binoculars.
